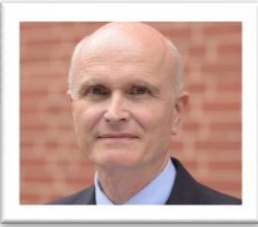

## Dear Colleagues,

the IX. Symposium on acute cardiology and emergency medicine will be held as “Charité meets Japan” addressing the burning questions of adequate usage of new drugs and diagnostic technologies in acute care.

Specifically in large cities like Berlin & Tokyo the access to the emergency department is very easy and it has been shown that patients look for a “doc to go” and think that the ED will provide more professional care and specifically more easy access to state of the art medical technologies including laboratory testing, ultrasound and CT/MRI. On the other hand, long waiting times, high costs and limited reimbursement challenge the future development of hospital based acute care. Many stakeholders prefer to strengthen the out-patient sector again with the vision of better resource utilization at lower costs. Modern concepts like the “Brustschmerzambulanz” in Germany which add on the hospital based CPUs and more easy access to high end technologies like “Point of care ultrasound” will maybe make a turning point and lead patients back to their family physicians. On the other hand, due to the uncertainty of the initial presentation, where a symptom can mean all or nothing, many doctors tend to go directly to definite diagnostic tools like the CT which is available 24/7 in the hospital ED only. Which is the way patients will try to go in the future?

Having Japan as a partner, we hope to learn about their concepts and experiences from mega-cities like Tokyo. We aim at bringing together all new information in a thought provoking manner to stimulate both the audience and the speakers to have an inspiring and fruitful day.
